- 4. To supervise / ensure that any drug / medicine used by the nursing / paramedical staff from the hospital supply / purchased from market is not of expiry period, so that the patient safety is not put a risk.

Further more, all Head of Units /Consultants of various surgical Units are requested to supervise avail ability of residents working under respective Units and to ensure discipline & punctuality. All the residents are advised to follow these instructions to avoid any disciplinary / administrative action in case of non compliance.
